

...THIS IS NOT HIS STORY.



Salinas Beach, where Lidia's dream takes place, a real place near the cemetery her mother is buried in








Dona Lena's House, which Lidia has inherited




Marsala Cemetery, where Dona Lena is buried

In partnership with Anika Noni Rose, we will collaborate with a popular Cabo Verdean female music artist to create an original song to underscore the short film

The track will be a combination of English & Kriolu, about the themes that Mudjer di Independensia highlights - womanhood, telling untold stories, embracing the significance of women's role in history

Not only will the song pull from the Batuku tradition, it will actively include batukadeira's in the writing and creative process, emphasizing a respect for authenticity

While in Cabo Verde, if our stretch goals are met, we will shoot a music video that will be released in tandem with the short film - opportunities to distribute across music platforms

Beyond showing the film around the world, intentional focus on partnering with local arts organizations on all 10 Cabo Verdean Islands for free screenings and talkbacks

Develop a relationship with the Cabo Verde Ministry of Culture & Creative Industries for assistance in promoting and distributing the film

Partner with educational institutions and organizations that celebrate and promote Cabo Verdean history and culture like Bridgewater State University Pedro Pires institute of Cape Verdean Studies, The Cape Verdean Association of Boston, the Cape Verdean Museum, Boston University, etc.

Mentorship and Professional Development

Inspire filmmakers and continue the growing effort to bring legitimate filmmaking to Cabo Verde and Fogo. We will be one of the few projects who intend to use majority local crew and cast.

Host workshops in Cabo Verde exploring the technical side of filmmaking (grips, electrical) in order to help build a knowledgeable crew base at the ground level so Cabo Verde can continue to grow into destination for filmmakers

francisca da silveira is a Cape Verde born, Boston raised playwright and tv writer. She was recently named a 2025 Women to Watch by the Broadway Women's Fund. Her produced plays include: CAN I TOUCH IT?, Rolling World Premiere at Company One Theatre (Boston), Rogue Machine Theatre (Los Angeles), and Cleveland Public Theatre (Cleveland); PAY NO WORSHIP, a 2023 Finalist for the Susan Smith Blackburn Prize and World Premiere at InterAct Theatre Company (Philadelphia) in April 2023; NOT- FOR-PROFIT (OR THE EQUITY, DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION PLAY), World Premiere at Cleveland Public Theatre in October 2024; and MINOR ITY, World Premiere at WP Theatre, co- produced by Colt Coeur (NYC) in April 2025.

da silveira was a 2020-2021 Playwrights Realm Writing Fellow, a member of The Public Theater's 2020-2023 Emerging Writers Group, a 2022-2023 Jerome Fellow with the Playwrights' Center, a member of The Apollo Theater's 2023 New Works Initiative Cohort, and a 2023 NYSCA commission recipient with The New Group (NYC). ANIKA NONI ROSE, Lead Actress & Executive Producer

Tony Award winner Anika Noni Rose is known around the world for having voiced 'Princess Tiana' in Disney's *The Princess and The Frog*, featuring the first African American Disney 'Princess.' The film received three Oscar nominations and Anika became the youngest inductee to ever be honored as a Disney Legend. She is the author of the children's book "Princess Tiana's Perfect Plan," and is currently voicing the animated series that will premiere on Disney+ in 2025. Anika also stars as Afia in the Disney movie, *Mufasa: The Lion King*.

She was last seen on the small screen in *Let The Right One In* based on the internationally best selling novel of the same name. She drew notice for her acclaimed performance as Regina in Netflix's most-watched limited series to date, *Maid*, opposite Margaret Qualley and Nick Robinson, for which she was nominated for "Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Television Movie, Limited-Series or Dramatic Special" at the 2022 NAACP Image Awards.

Rose appeared in Jingle Jangle: A Christmas Journey (Netflix), Lena Waithe's horror anthology Them (Amazon) and Little Fires Everywhere (Hulu) with Reese Witherspoon and Kerry Washington. Additionally, Anika led the cast of BET's series The Quad as Eva Fletcher for two seasons and in 2017, she starred in the film Everything, Everything based off the popular young adult novel of the same name by Nicola Yoon.

Continuing to take on iconic characters, Anika starred in the History Channel's adaption of *Roots* as Kizzy (NAACP Image Award nomination). On the big screen, Anika starred as 'Lorell Robinson' in *Dreamgirls* (AFI Ensemble Award, SAG Award nomination, Grammy Award nomination).

Additional television and film credits include: Power, The Good Wife, The Simpsons, and The No. 1 Ladies' Detective Agency, For Colored Girls; Half of A Yellow Sun and Assassination Nation.

Anika most recently starred in the critically acclaimed revival of Uncle Vanya, on Broadway alongside Steve Carell. She won the Tony Award for Best Featured Actress in a Musical for her role in Caroline, or Change (Lucille Lortel Award, Theatre World Award, Obie Award, Clarence Derwent Award, Drama Desk nomination). Additional Broadway credits: A Raisin in the Sun (Tony Award nomination and Outer Critics Circle nomination), Cat On A Hot Tin Roof, Footloose. Additional stage credits include Carmen Jones for which she won a Lucille Lortel Award, an AUDELCO award and received Drama Desk and Outer Critics Circle nominations; the New York Philharmonic's production of Company and Broadway's Cat On A Hot Tin Roof directed by Debbie Allen.

A nine-time NAACP Image Award nominee, Rose has voiced many audiobooks, and has performed sold out concerts all over the world, including singing at Carnegie Hall and the Vatican.
